The Five Beliefs about God's Power

God's power is **nonexistent**.

God's power is **invisible**.

God's power is **manipulative**.

God's power is **miraculous**.

God's power is **infinite**.

Doubt affects our **trust**; we lose boldness.

our **obedience**; we become dismissive.

our **participation** in God's plan.
